The Students of the Culinary Arts Program at Washtenaw Community College prepare dinner for us as part of their class.



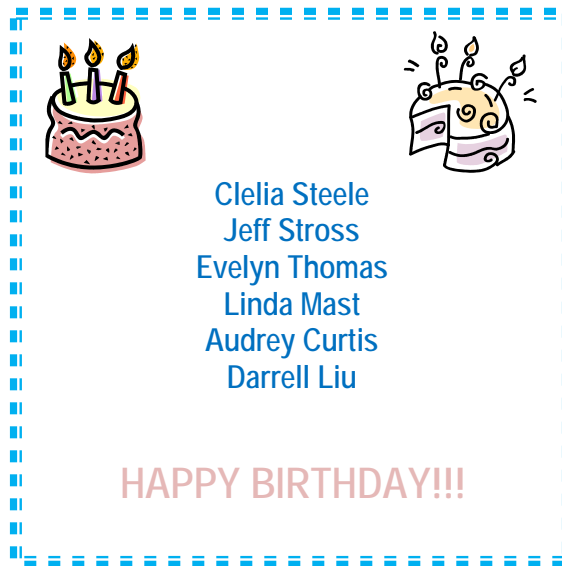

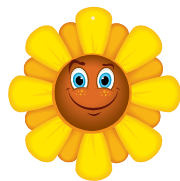
